

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4504**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. ROUKEMA**

Page 29, line 3, strike “subparagraph” and insert “subparagraphs”.

Page 29, line 12, strike the quotation mark and the final period.

Page 29, after line 12, insert the following:

- 1           “(J) A description of campus fire safety prac-
- 2           tices and standards, including-
- 3                 “(i) information with respect to each cam-
- 4           pus residence hall and whether or not such hall
- 5           is equipped with a fire sprinkler system or other
- 6           fire safety system;
- 7                 “(ii) statistics concerning the occurrence
- 8           on campus of fires and false alarms in residence
- 9           halls, including information on deaths, injuries,
- 10          and structural damage caused by such occur-
- 11          rences, if any, during the 2 preceding calendar
- 12          years for which such data are available; and
- 13                 “(iii) information regarding fire alarms,
- 14          smoke alarms, fire escape planning or protocols
- 15          (as defined in local fire codes), rules on portable
- 16          electrical appliances, smoking and open flames,

1 regular mandatory supervised fire drills, and  
2 any planned improvements in fire safety.”.

3 Page 29, after line 15, insert the following (and re-  
4 designate any subsequent provisions accordingly):

5 (8) Section 485(f) is further amended-

6 (A) in paragraph (3), by inserting after  
7 the first sentence the following: “In addition,  
8 each such institution shall make periodic re-  
9 ports to the campus community regarding fires  
10 and false fire alarms that are reported to a  
11 local fire department.”;

12 (B) in paragraph (5)-

13 (i) by striking “paragraph (I)(F)”  
14 and inserting “subparagraphs (F) and (J)”  
15 of paragraph (1);

16 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by striking  
17 “education, identify” and all that follows  
18 through the end and inserting the fol-  
19 lowing: “education, identify-

20 “(i) exemplary campus security policies,  
21 procedures, and practices and disseminate in-  
22 formation concerning those policies, procedures,  
23 and practices that have proven effective in the  
24 reduction of campus crime; and

1           “(ii) fire safety polices, procedures, and  
2 practices and disseminate information con-  
3 cerning those policies procedures and practices  
4 that have proven effective in the reduction of  
5 fires on campus.”; and

6                   (iii) by adding at the end the fol-  
7 lowing:

8           “(D) not later than July 1, 2002, prepare and  
9 submit a report to Congress containing-

10                   “(i) an analysis of the current status  
11 of fire safety systems in college and univer-  
12 sity facilities, including sprinkler systems;

13                   “(ii) an analysis of the appropriate  
14 fire safety standards to apply to these fa-  
15 cilities, which the Secretary shall compare  
16 after consultation with such fire safety ex-  
17 perts, representatives of institutions of  
18 higher education, and Federal agencies as  
19 the Secretary, in the Secretary’s discretion,  
20 considers appropriate;

21                   “(iii) an estimate of the cost of bring-  
22 ing all nonconforming residence halls and  
23 other campus buildings into compliance  
24 with appropriate building codes; and

1                   “(iv) recommendations concerning the  
2                   best means of meeting fire safety stand-  
3                   ards in all college facilities, including rec-  
4                   ommendations for methods of funding such  
5                   costs.”.
