

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 609  
OFFERED BY MS. FOXX OF NORTH CAROLINA**

**Databases of student information**

After section 108 of the Amendment, insert the following new section (and redesignate the succeeding sections accordingly):

1 **SEC. 109. DATABASES OF STUDENT INFORMATION.**

2 Part B of title I is further amended by adding at  
3 the end the following new section:

4 **“SEC. 132. DATABASES OF STUDENT INFORMATION PRO-**  
5 **HIBITED.**

6 “(a) PROHIBITION.—Except as described in (b),  
7 nothing in this Act shall be construed to authorize the de-  
8 sign, development, creation, implementation, or mainte-  
9 nance of a nationwide database of personally identifiable  
10 information on individuals receiving assistance, attending  
11 institutions receiving assistance, or otherwise involved in  
12 any studies or other collections of data under this Act,  
13 including a student unit record system, an education bar  
14 code system, or any other system that tracks individual  
15 students over time.



1           “(b) EXCEPTION.—The provisions of subsection (a)  
2 shall not affect the loan obligation enforcement activities  
3 described in section 485B of this Act.”.
